STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Springvale Aqueduct
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter four hundred and thirty-eight of the special laws of one thousand nine hundred and one is hereby amended, so as to read as follows:

Sect. 2. Said corporation shall have the exclusive right so long as it shall continue to supply water for the purposes aforesaid, so far as necessary for such purposes, to take water from Littlefield pond in said Sanford for the purposes aforesaid, and shall have the power to raise the water in said pond subject to the statutes of the State relating to flowage; and shall have the right also to take water, for

11 such purposes, from the Mousam river and its tributaries;
12 and may enter and take land for the purpose of laying and
13 constructing their pipes or aqueducts, building reservoirs,
14 erecting gate houses, repairing such aqueducts, pipes, res-
15 ervoirs and gate houses, and to do all other acts and things
16 reasonable and proper in the construction and maintenance
17 and completion of the aforementioned works.
