STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to establish a Board of State Park Commissioners and to define its powers and duties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Governor by and with the advice and con-2 sent of the Council, shall appoint three persons to be known 3 as the State Park Commissioners, who shall hold office for 4 two years from the first day of July, nineteen hundred and 5 thirteen. Said commissioners shall consider the advisability 6 of laying out ample open spaces, reservations, roadways, and 7 boulevards for the use of the public in the cities and towns 8 of Maine, and shall have authority to make maps and plans

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9 of such open spaces, reservations, roadways and boulevards, 10 and to collect such information in relation thereto as they 11 may deem expedient. They shall report to the Legislature 12 of 1915 on or before the second Wednesday of January, a 13 comprehensive preliminary plan for acquiring, laying out 14 and maintaining such open spaces, reservations, roadways 15 and boulevards.

Sect. 2. Said commissioners may employ such assistants 2 and expend such funds in the discharge of their duties, in-3 cluding actual traveling expenses of said members and their 4 assistants, as the Governor and Council may determine.

Said commissioners shall receive no compensation.
