RESOLVE, in favor of the city of Biddeford.

Resolved: That the sum of five hundred and seventy dol2 lars and seventeen cents, be and is hereby appropriated, to be
3 paid by the Treasurer of State to the city of Biddeford out
4 of moneys of the state not otherwise appropriated, for
5 money expended by the city of Biddeford for the care and
6 support of Joseph Labelle, a state insane pauper, and said
7 sum shall be paid only on vouchers produced on said city of
8 Biddeford, and approved by the Governor and Council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Joseph Labell was committed to the Insane Asylum at Augusta from the city of Biddeford on or about Feb. 28, 1894, and was an inmate thereof until Feb. 4, 1910. For his care and support the City of Biddeford paid to the State the sum of two thousand two hundred and fifty-five dollars and sixty-five cents, but said city has been reimbursed by order of the Governor and Council, and the sum of one hundred fifty-eight dollars and eleven cents, and one thousand five hundred and twenty-seven dollars and thirty-seven cents was contracted prior to March 23rd, 1905, so that the claim of said city against the State, in this case is five hundred and seventy dollars and seventeen The affidavits of this case are on file in the office of the state auditor, and can be used as evidence when needed by the committee. The claim was filed with the affidavits with the Governor and Council in 1909, and the City of Biddeford was reimbursed by the State through the action of the Governor and Council for all moneys disbursed by the city of Biddeford after Nov. 30, 1908. The claim of the city of Biddeford against the state is for reimbursement for sums paid out prior to that date on account of the care and support of the said Joseph Labelle.
