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STATE OF MAINE

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RESOLVE, in favor of the Commissioner of Agriculture in  
his capacity as Sealer of Weights and Measures.

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*Resolved:* That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for the  
3 year 1913, and the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars  
4 (\$2,500) for the year 1914, to be expended by the Commis-  
5 sioner of Agriculture as Sealer of Weights and Measures,  
6 to carry out the provisions of Chapter eighty-two (82) of  
7 the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven.



## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The legislature of 1911 made the Commissioner of Agriculture the State Sealer of Weights and Measures, but no appropriation was made to carry out the provisions of the statute.
