STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Maine Seed Improvement Association.

Resolved: That the sum of five hundred dollars be and 2 hereby is appropriated annually, for the use of the Maine 3 Seed Improvement Association, for the purpose of encour-4 aging the breeding and development of pure seed; said ap-5 propriation to be expended in employing speakers, paying 6 premiums and all other necessary expenses of holding an 7 annual meeting of said association in Maine. This appro-8 priation shall be expended under the direction of the Com-9 missioner of Agriculture, upon the presentation of the prop-10 er vouchers.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Maine Seed Improvement Association was organized for the purpose of encouraging the breeding and development of pure seed, and assisting the farmers in the development of seed which will produce larger and better crops. The within appropriation is necessary in order to pay the expenses of holding an annual meeting of said association, and is to be expended in employing speakers, paying premiums and other necessary expenses of holding such meeting.
