STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Jonesport Central
Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the
2 Jonesport Central Railroad Company which were granted
3 by chapter ninety-seven of the Private and Special Laws
4 of the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-nine
5 are hereby extended for a period of two years from the
6 time this act shall go into effect, and the persons named in
7 said chapter ninety-seven, their associates, successors and
8 assigns, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges

9 that were granted them by said chapter ninety-seven to be
10 exercised in the same manner and for the same purpose as
11 therein specified.

Sect. 2. Section one of said chapter ninety-seven of the
2 Private and Special Laws for nineteen hundred and ninety-
3 nine is hereby amended by adding to and including in the
4 incorporators named therein Terence B. Towle of Bangor.
