RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell, to provide for the payment of unused interest on trust funds.

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated in 2 favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallo-  
3 well the sum of one thousand two hundred sixty dollars  
4 and six cents, such sum being the amount of unused inter-  
5 est on trust funds deposited in the state treasury, for the  
6 years nineteen hundred nine, nineteen hundred ten, nine-  
7 teen hundred eleven and nineteen hundred twelve.



## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The following trust funds, the interest on which is payable toward the support of the Maine Industrial School for Girls, are on deposit in the state treasury: Nellie F. Shaw fund, \$4,750; Augustus Hopkins legacy, \$1,000; Eliza Mustard legacy, \$3,912.50; Peter Lane legacy, \$1,156.65. For the years nineteen hundred nine, nineteen hundred ten, nineteen hundred eleven, and nineteen hundred twelve the income from these funds was not entirely used, a balance of one thousand two hundred sixty dollars and six cents remaining unexpended. This resolve calls for the reappropriation of this balance.
