STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell, to provide for the payment of unused interest on trust funds.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in 2 favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallo-3 well the sum of one thousand two hundred sixty dollars 4 and six cents, such sum being the amount of unused inter-5 est on trust funds deposited in the state treasury, for the 6 years nineteen hundred nine, nineteen hundred ten, nine-7 teen hundred eleven and nineteen hundred twelve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The following trust funds, the interest on which is payable toward the support of the Maine Industrial School for Girls, are on deposit in the state treasury: Nellie F. Shaw fund, \$4,750; Augustus Hopkins legacy, \$1,000; Eliza Mustard legacy, \$3,912.50; Peter Lane legacy, \$1,156.65. For the years nineteen hundred nine, nineteen hundred ten, nineteen hundred eleven, and nineteen hundred twelve the income from these funds was not entirely used, a balance of one thousand two hundred sixty dollars and six cents remaining unexpended. This resolve calls for the reappropriation of this balance.
