STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell to provide for the payment of interest on trust funds deposited in the state treasury.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in

- 2 favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell
- 3 the sum of five hundred and forty dollars and ninety-six
- 4 cents for the year nineteen hundred thirteen and a like sum
- 5 for the year nineteen hundred fourteen such sums being
- 6 the amounts of the interest payable on the Lane, Shaw,
- 7 Hopkins and Mustard funds, so called, deposited in the
- 8 state treasury.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The following trust funds, the interest on which is payable toward the support of the Maine Industrial School for girls, are on deposit in the state treasury; Nellie F. Shaw fund, \$4,750; Augustus Hopkins legacy, \$1,000; Eliza Mustard legacy, \$3,912.50; Peter Lane legacy, \$1,156.65. The amount called for in the accompanying resolve is for the payment of interest on said fund in acordance with the terms of deposit.
