## STATE OF MAINE

---

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell to provide for the payment of interest on trust funds deposited in the state treasury.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated in  
2 favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell  
3 the sum of five hundred and forty dollars and ninety-six  
4 cents for the year nineteen hundred thirteen and a like sum  
5 for the year nineteen hundred fourteen such sums being  
6 the amounts of the interest payable on the Lane, Shaw,  
7 Hopkins and Mustard funds, so called, deposited in the  
8 state treasury.



## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The following trust funds, the interest on which is payable toward the support of the Maine Industrial School for girls, are on deposit in the state treasury; Nellie F. Shaw fund, \$4,750; Augustus Hopkins legacy, \$1,000; Eliza Mustard legacy, \$3,912.50; Peter Lane legacy, \$1,156.65. The amount called for in the accompanying resolve is for the payment of interest on said fund in accordance with the terms of deposit.
