STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the State School for Boys at South Portland, for general maintenance.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated for
2 the State School for Boys at South Portland the sum of
3 thirty-six thousand five hundred dollars for the year nine-
4 teen hundred thirteen and the sum of thirty-six thousand
5 five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fourteen,
6 such sums to be expended under the direction of trustees
7 of juvenile institutions for maintenance of said school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The appropriation called for in this resolve is for the maintenance of the State School for Boys at South Portland. The appropriation is for the purpose of paying salaries of all officers, general supplies and other items connected with the conduct of the institution. The increase in the appropriation indicated for 1914 is to provide for the maintenance of an additional cottage, provision for the construction of which is asked in a separate resolve.
