STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT additional to chapter four of the Revised Statutes,
relating to appointment of town auditors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. When by reason of non-acceptance, death, re-
2 moval, insanity or other incompetency of a person elected
3 to the office of town auditor, there is a vacancy in said
4 office, the selectmen may appoint a person to fill said office,
5 who shall perform all the duties of said office until an audi-
6 tor is elected by the town at its next annual meeting. Said
7 person so appointed, shall be duly sworn.
