IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

---

AN ACT to provide for the distribution of State School Funds.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one hundred and twenty-six of chap-  
2 ter fifteen of the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred and  
3 three is hereby amended so that said section one hundred  
4 and twenty-six, as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 126. This fund shall be distributed by the treasurer  
6 of state on the first day of January, annually, to the several  
7 cities, towns and plantations according to the aggregate  
8 attendance of scholars at the elementary public schools  
9 therein, as the same shall appear from the official returns  
10 made to the state superintendent of public schools for the  
11 preceding year.'

Sect. 2. Section three of chapter one hundred and seventy-seven of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby amended so that said section three, as amended, shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 3. This fund shall be distributed by the treasurer of state on the first day of January, annually, to the several cities, towns and plantations according to the aggregate attendance of scholars at the elementary public schools therein, as the same shall appear from the official returns made to the state superintendent of public schools for the preceding year.’

Sect. 3. The aggregate attendance in any city, town or plantation, shall be determined by computing the grand total of the number of days and fractional parts thereof that the total number of scholars may have been in attendance at all the elementary public schools therein during said preceding year.

Sect. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
