RESOLVE in favor of the town of Howland.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of five hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$525) for 3 the purpose of repairing the bridge across the Piscataquis 4 river in the town of Howland: provided there be appro-5 priated by said town of Howland or otherwise, the sum 6 of five hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$525) for the same 7 purpose: both sums to be expended under the supervision 8 of the State Highway Department.
