STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT Additional to Chapter Seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes Relating to Transfer of Actions and Other Matters to the Law Court in Case of Death of Presiding Justice.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. In case of physical or mental disability, death,
resignation, or removal of the justice presiding at any civil
or criminal proceeding before the supreme judicial or supetior court, or at a hearing in equity, in which, a motion for
new trial is made, exceptions presented or appeal taken, any
justice of the supreme judicial court may, upon motion,
exercise the powers and perform the duties of such presidsing justice in transferring such actions and other matters
to the law court.
