STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend section forty of chapter twenty-nine of the Revised Statutes relating to the sale of Intoxicating Liquors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty of chapter twenty-nine of the Re-

- 2 vised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out after the
- 3 word "beer" in the fourth line thereof, the words "and all
- 4 other malt liquors", so that said section as amended shall
- 5 read as follows:

'Sect. 40. No person shall at any time, by himself, his

- 7 clerk, servant or agent, directly or indirectly, sell any intoxi-
- 8 cating liquors of whatever origin, except as hereinbefore
- 9 provided; wine, ale, porter, strong beer, lager beer, and

10 cider when kept or deposited with intent to sell the same 11 for tippling purposes, or as a beverage, as well as all dis-12 tilled spirits, are declared intoxicating within the meaning 13 of this chapter; but this enumeration shall not prevent any 14 other pure or mixed liquors from being considered intoxi-15 cating.'
