STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section seventeen of Chapter thirty-two as amended by Section four, Chapter one hundred thirty-two of the Public Laws of 1905, in relation to close time on deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The first paragraph of section seventeen of

- 2 chapter thirty-two, as amended by section four, chapter one
- 3 hundred thirty-two of the Public Laws of 1905, is hereby
- 4 amended by striking out the words "fifteenth" after the
- 5 words "December" in the fourth and fifth lines and sub-
- 6 stituting therefor the words 'first,' so that said paragraph
- 7 shall read as follows:

'No person shall, except as hereinafter provided, hunt, take,

9 catch, kill or have in possession for any purpose whenever 10 or wherever taken, caught or killed, any deer, or part there11 of, between December first and October first next follow12 ing; no person shall between October first and December 13 first next following, except as hereinafter provided, take, 14 catch, kill or have in possession for any purpose whenever 15 or wherever taken, caught or killed, more than two deer or 16 parts thereof; a person lawfully killing a deer in open sea17 son shall have a reasonable time in which to transport the 18 same to his home and may have the same in possession at 19 his home in close season.'
