IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

---

AN ACT to amend Chapter Four Hundred and Fifty-five of  
the Private and Special laws of the year one thousand eight  
hundred and ninety-seven, relating to the increase of the  
capital of Good Will Home Association, a charitable cor-  
poration.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter four hundred and fifty-  
2 five of the Private and Special Laws of the year one thou-  
3 sand eight hundred and ninety-seven, is hereby amended by  
4 striking out the words "hundred thousand," between the  
5 words "five" and "dollars," so that said section shall read  
6 as follows:

“Section 1. The Good Will Home Association, a charitable  
8 corporation formed under the provisions of chapter fifty-  
9 five of the Revised Statutes, for the purpose of aiding needy  
10 boys, and located at Fairfield in Somerset county, is hereby  
11 authorized to take and hold by purchase, gift, devise or be-  
12 quest, personal or real estate in all not exceeding five million  
13 dollars owned at any one time.”

Section 2. All acts and proceedings of said association and  
2 its officers heretofore taken in receiving funds and holding,  
3 managing and expending the same in the interests of needy  
4 boys and girls, in pursuance of said organization, so far  
5 as any technical errors or informalities, if any, are con-  
6 cerned, are hereby legalized.
