STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Farmington State Normal School.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of twenty thousand dollars for the year nineteen hun-
3 dred thirteen and the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars
4 for the year nineteen hundred fourteen to be expended un-
5 der the direction of the state normal school trustees for the
6 construction of a dormitory at the Farmington state normal
7 school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Farmington state normal school, the oldest of the state normal schools, has no dormitory. The need of a dormitory is imperative, especially as three of the other state normal schools already have dormitories and the lack of one in this instance proves a serious handicap. It is becoming more difficult yearly to provide for the housing of students at this school. A site for such a building has already been purchased, this purchase being authorized through the action of the legislature of nineteen hundred nine.
