STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Washington State Normal School to provide for the partial construction of a new dormitory.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of ten thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred 3 thirteen and the sum of twenty thousand dollars for the year 4 nineteen hundred fourteen to provide for the partial con-5 struction of a new dormitory at the Washington State Nor-6 mal School at Machias. .

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

There is no provision at the Washington State Normal School for the boarding students except such as is provided in the homes of citizens. The difficulty of securing a sufficient number of satisfactory boarding places suggests the necessity of a dormitory for students and teachers. Many parents desiring to send their daughters to a normal school are reluctant to send them to a school where they are not to be under direct supervision of the teachers. This situation it is believed prevents the satisfactory growth and development of the institution.
