STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to require loan brokers to obtain licenses from municipal officers of cities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person or persons shall for himself or

- 2 themselves or for another make loans or advertise to make
- 3 loans such as are described in chapter 46 of the Revised
- 4 Statutes as amended, and charge therefor interest at the
- 5 rate of more than 10 per cent per annum, without first
- 6 obtaining from the municipal officers of the town or city
- 7 where the business is conducted, a license for making such
- 8 loans. Such license shall not run exceeding one year, and

- 9 shall be granted only to persons of good moral character, 10 and shall be revoked for violation of law or for violation 11 of the police regulations of said town or city.
 - Sect. 2. Whoever, for himself or for another, makes or 2 advertises to make such loans without a license, forfeits not 3 exceeding one hundred dollars, to be recovered by the town 4 or city on complaint or indictment.
