IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

 $AN\ ACT$ to extend the charter of the Fairfield and Skowhegan Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Fair-

- 2 field and Skowhegan Railway Company, which were granted
- 3 by chapter two hundred and sixty of the Private and Special
- 4 Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, and extended by chap-
- 5 ter fifty-two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
- 6 hundred and eleven are hereby extended for two years from
- 7 the approval of this act, and the persons named in said act.
- 8 their associates and successors, shall have all the rights,
- 9 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act,
- 10 to be exercised in the same manner and for the same pur-
- II poses as provided in said act.
