STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Fairfield and Skowhegan
Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Fair-
2 field and Skowhegan Railway Company, which were granted
3 by chapter two hundred and sixty of the Private and Special
4 Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, and extended by chap-
5 ter fifty-two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
6 hundred and eleven are hereby extended for two years from
7 the approval of this act, and the persons named in said act,
8 their associates and successors, shall have all the rights,
9 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act,
10 to be exercised in the same manner and for the same pur-
11 poses as provided in said act.
