STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell for general maintenance.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor
2 of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell the
3 sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for the year nineteen
4 hundred thirteen and the sum of twenty-five thousand dol-
5 lars for the year nineteen hundred fourteen, to be expended
6 under the direction of the trustees of juvenile institutions
7 for the maintenance of said school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The appropriation asked for in this resolve is for the purpose of meeting the current expenses of the Maine Industrial School for Girls.
