STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell for renewals and repairs on all buildings.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor 2 of the Maine Industrial School for Girls the sum of five 3 hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred thirteen and 4 the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hun-5 dred fourteen, such sums to be expended under the direction 6 of the trustees of juvenile institutions for renewals and re-7 pairs on all buildings at said institution.
