#### STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Town of Limestone.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of eighty-one dollars (\$81) to be paid to the town of

- 3 Limestone to reimburse said town of Limestone for moneys
- 4 paid to the state through error of the officers of said town
- 5 of Limestone.



#### STATEMENT OF FACT.

When the dog tax was reported by the town officers of the town of Limestone for the year 1911, a clerical error was made whereby the town, as per the officers' report, was short \$81 and the said \$81 was charged and added to the state tax of 1912 and paid into the state treasury together with the state tax of that year.
