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STATE OF MAINE

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RESOLVE making appropriations for the Passamaquoddy  
Tribe of Indians.

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*Resolved,* Whereas, the state of Maine holds in trust for  
2 the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians a certain large sum of  
3 money, to wit: thirty-three thousand one hundred and forty  
4 dollars and seventy cents, and whereas all funds appropri-  
5 ated by the seventy-fifth legislature for the care, mainte-  
6 nance and relief of said tribe have been expended for the  
7 purposes and in the manner prescribed by law, and because  
8 of the lack of available funds, said tribe may fall into dis-  
9 tress and be deprived of proper food, shelter and clothing.

Whereas, by reason of the foregoing facts the appropria-  
11 tion called for in this resolve is immediately necessary for  
12 the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and  
13 in the opinion of this legislature constitutes an emergency  
14 as contemplated by the constitution, be it therefore

*Resolved*, That there be paid from the state treasury, to  
 16 be expended under the direction of the governor and coun-  
 17 cil, to the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians for  
 18 the benefit of said tribe for the years nineteen hundred and  
 19 thirteen and nineteen hundred and fourteen as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACTS TO ACCOMPANY RESOLVE  
 MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PASSAMAQUODDY  
 TRIBE OF INDIANS.

The State of Maine holds in trust certain lands and funds belonging to Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians, the income from which, together with certain appropriations are regularly used for the support and maintenance of tribe; and to prevent their falling into want.

The accompanying resolve calls for the regular appropriations, together with certain amounts for special purposes which the conditions at Pleasant Point and Peter Dana's Point render necessary, as follows:

For repair on roads at Pleasant Point.....	\$100
For fence for cemetery .....	200
For repair or rebuilding lock-up .....	200
For repair and painting of buildings.....	150
For repair and painting of buildings at Peter Dana's Pt. ....	150
For fuel for church and school we ask an extra amount of .....	100
