HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to revive and extend the power of the Litchfield  
Electrical Company.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Litch-  
2 field Electrical Company, which were granted by chapter  
3 three hundred and fifty-five of the Private and Special Laws  
4 of nineteen hundred and nine, are hereby revived and ex-  
5 tended for two years, from the date when this act shall  
6 take effect; and the persons named in said original act, their  
7 associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers  
8 and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be  
9 exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes  
10 as specified in said act.
