STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to revive and extend the power of the Litchfield Electrical Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. The rights, powers and privileges of the Litch-2 field Electrical Company, which were granted by chapter 3 three hundred and fifty-five of the Private and Special Laws 4 of nineteen hundred and nine, are hereby revived and ex-5 tended for two years, from the date when this act shall 6 take effect; and the persons named in said original act, their 7 associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers 8 and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be 9 exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes 10 as specified in said act.
