STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Town of Wade.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Township number thirteen in the fourth range
2 of townships, west from the east line of the state of Maine,
3 in the county of Aroostook, and known as Wade Plantation,
4 is hereby incorporated as a town under the name of Wade;
5 and the inhabitants thereof are hereby invested with all the
6 powers and privileges and subject to the duties and liabilities
7 incident to other towns in this state.

Sect. 2. The collectors of the plantation of Wade shall
2 have power to finish the collection of all taxes which shall
3 have been committed to them for collection prior to the

4 passage of this act, and to settle with and pay the same to
5 the treasurer of the town of Wade; and the several officers
6 of said plantation are empowered to perform all the duties
7 of town officers in the town created by this act, until their
8 successors shall have been legally chosen and qualified as
9 town officers of the town of Wade under this act.

Sect. 3. Any justice of the peace may call the first meet-
2 ing of the town of Wade by issuing his warrant therefor,
3 stating the objects of said meeting, directed to any inhab-
4 itant of said town, directing him to warn and notify the
5 inhabitants of said town qualified to vote in town affairs,
6 to assemble at the time and place appointed, and the person
7 to whom such warrant is directed shall give notice of such
8 meeting by posting an attested copy of said warrant in three
9 public and conspicuous places in said town at least seven
10 days before said meeting.

Sect. 4. All property now belonging to Wade Plantation
2 shall belong to, and the title thereof is hereby vested in the
3 town of Wade.

Sect. 5. The persons hereafter becoming chargeable as
2 paupers within the limits of said town shall be chargeable
3 to said town of Wade, excepting those who are now state
4 paupers.
