STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the permanent improvement and repair of "The New Kenduskeag Road" in the Town of Glenburn.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) 2 be and is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred 3 and thirteen from any unexpended balance now in the treas-4 ury, for the permanent improvement and repair of the 5 "New Kenduskeag Road" in the town of Glenburn, Penob-6 scot county, to be expended under the supervision of the 7 State Highway Department.

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STATEMENT OF FACT.

The road herein referred to is a part of the direct road leading from Bangor to Kenduskeag, Corinth, Dover and Foxcroft, Guilford, Monson and Moosehead Lake. It is of little importance to the people of Glenburn. The town of Glenburn is not financially able to put the road in suitable condition to meet the demands of the public. Said town appropriated and expended \$200 on this road in 1912 and contemplates appropriating as much or more in 1913. Mileage of this road in this town, $2\frac{1}{2}$ to 3 miles.

Valuation of Glenburn, \$173,533. Rate of taxation, 2%.
