STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Michael Burns.

Resolved, That Michael Burns be authorized to bring suit 2 at common law in the supreme judicial court against the 3 state of Maine for damages claimed to have been sustained 4 by him on account of a criminal prosecution begun in the 5 year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven; and, if it appears 6 that such prosecution was begun and carried on by the order 7 of the executive, that said Burns shall have the same right 8 to maintain suit against the state and to recover damages 9 that he would have against an individual for the same prose-10 cution where the action is not barred by the statute of limita-11 tions.

Any damages that may be recovered in such suit shall be 13 payable from the state treasury out of any moneys not other-14 wise appropriated.
