RESOLVE in favor of Vinnie E. Saunders.

*Resolved,* That there be paid to Vinnie E. Saunders, daughter of Elijah Saunders of Trescott, in the county of Washington, state of Maine, the sum of ten dollars per month, payable quarterly, from the fund appropriated for military pensions, and to begin January first, nineteen hundred and thirteen, and continue at the will and pleasure of the governor and council.
