STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in aid of building a bridge across the Mattawam-
keag River in Moro Plantation.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500) to aid in re-
3 building the lower bridge, so called, in Moro plantation,
4 county of Aroostook, provided that there be raised and
5 appropriated by the county of Aroostook, the plantation
6 of Moro, and the town of Hersey, or otherwise, the sum
7 of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500) for the same pur-
8 pose; both sums to be expended under the supervision of
9 the State Highway Department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The lower bridge across the Mattawamkeag river in Moro Plantation must be rebuilt at once. The inhabitants of the plantation are not financially able to do this, as a suitable bridge and approaches will cost approximately five thousand dollars (\$5000).

The real estate in said plantation is valued at fifty-six thousand one hundred forty-four dollars (\$56,144). The personal property in said plantation is valued at eight thousand five hundred and forty-one dollars (\$8,541). The tax rate is thirty-four mills on a dollar, and there are forty-nine taxable polls in the plantation.
