STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Madawaska Training School at Fort Kent.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor 2 of the Madawaska Training School at Fort Kent the sum 3 of two thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen 4 hundred thirteen and the sum of two thousand five hundred 5 dollars for the year nineteen hundred fourteen, such amounts 6 to be expended under the direction of the trustees of the 7 state normal schools for painting buildings, shingling, grad-8 ing grounds, constructing walks, lighting, and other repairs 9 and permanent improvements.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This appropriation is required in order to prevent the deterioration of property and for necessary repairs and permanent improvements at the Madawaska Training School. The repairs and improvements required include the painting of the school buildings and dormitory, shingling, grading grounds and constructing new walks and for a safe system of lighting.
