STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the Protection of Moose.

Bc it chacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall at any time hunt, take, catch,
2 kill, destroy or have in possession any cow or calf moose or
3 part thereof; and the term "calf moose," as herein used,
4 shall be construed to mean that these animals are calves
5 until they are at least one year old, and have at least two
6 prongs or times not less than three inches long to each of
7 their horns.

No person shall, between the first day of December of one each year and the thirty-first day of October of the follow-to ing year, both days inclusive, hunt, take, catch, kill, destroy or have in possession any bull moose or part thereof, and

12 no person shall, during the month of November of each year 13 hunt, take, catch, kill, destroy or have in possession more 14 than one bull moose or part thereof.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine 16 not exceeding two hundred dollars and costs for each 17 offense or be imprisoned not exceeding four months.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act 2 are hereby repealed.
