#### STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE. HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section one hundred fifteen of Chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes relating to the appropriation for the support of the normal and training schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Section one hundred fifteen of chapter fifteen
2 of the Revised Statutes as amended is hereby further amend3 ed by striking out the words "seventy-seven thousand five
4 hundred" in the third and fourth lines thereof and substi5 tuting therefor the words 'eighty-five thousand,' and by
6 triking out the word "eleven" in the fourth line thereof and
7 substituting therefor the word 'thirteen,' and by striking out
8 the words "seventy-seven thousand five hundred" in the

9 fourth and fifth lines thereof and substituting therefor the 10 words 'eighty-five thousand,' so that said section when 11 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 115. For the support of the five normal schools 13 and the Madawaska training school, the sum of eighty-five 14 thousand dollars is appropriated for the year nineteen hun-15 dred thirteen and the sum of eighty-five thousand dollars 16 is annually appropriated thereafter, to be expended under 17 the direction of said trustees, which sum the treasurer of 18 state shall deduct for said purpose from any school money 19 raised for the support of common schools. The governor 20 and council may, from time to time, as they think proper, 21 draw warrants therefor on said treasurer in favor of said 22 trustees.'

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

An increase in the appropriation for the state normal schools amounting to \$7,500 annually is involved in this amendment. This increase becomes necessary to meet the expanding needs of the institutions.
