STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Western State Normal School at
Gorham for repairs and permanent improvements.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor
2 of the Western State Normal School at Gorham the sum
3 of fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred
4 thirteen and the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the year
5 nineteen hundred fourteen, such sums to be expended under
6 the direction of the trustees of the state normal schools for
7 repairs and permanent improvements at said school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The following items of repairs and permanent improvements are required at the Western State Normal School: Repairs and additions to granolithic walks, repairs on driveways, grading school grounds, painting exterior of school buildings and interior of many rooms, additional furnishings for library, enlarging toilet and dressing room facilities, providing a safe and filing case for Principal's office, changing of partitions to enlarge assembly room, furnishing seventy-five seats and desks for the assembly room, equipment and improvements in the gymnasium, alterations of Academy Hall for the manual training department, incidental repairs, replacing wornout furnishings.
