STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to changing the name of Gregory's Sana-
torium at Boothbay Harbor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The words "Gregory Sanatorium" in the fourth
2 line, section one chapter three hundred and forty-nine, Laws
3 of nineteen hundred and nine, are hereby struck out and
4 the words 'St. Andrew's Hospital' are inserted in their place,
5 so said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. Doctor George A. Gregory, Dr. E. A. Sprague
7 and Emma B. Day, their associates and successors, are here-
8 by incorporated and made a body politic by the name of

9 St. Andrew's Hospital, and by that name may sue and be
10 sued, and may have a common seal, and shall have all the
11 immunities and privileges and be subject to all the liabilities
12 of like corporations.'
