

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars be and 2 hereby is appropriated to be paid to Grenville M. Donham, 3 of Portland, for four hundred copies of the Maine State 4 Year Book and Legislative Manual of 1912 and 1913.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The legislature of 1911 passed an order providing for the purchase by the state of 600 copies of the Year Book; 200 copies to be delivered in 1911 and 400 copies in 1912. The first 200 copies were paid for, but no provision was made for the payment of the 400 copies for 1912. Said 400 copies were delivered in September, 1912, and have been used as contemplated in the order providing for their purchase.
