STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVED to authorize and provide for purchase of the
History of the Town of Garland.

Resolved, That the State Librarian, under the supervision
2 of the governor and council, and in conformity to the policy
3 of the State to aid in the publication and preservation of
4 histories of towns, be and hereby is authorized to purchase
5 one hundred copies of the history of the town of Garland
6 at the price not exceeding two dollars per copy; and it is
7 further resolved that there be and hereby is appropriated
8 the sum of two hundred dollars for the above purpose.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This history of the town of Garland in Penobscot county is the only one compiled and printed; it covers the historical and biographical events from the ceding of territory by Massachusetts. It was most carefully and accurately edited by Hon. Lyndon Oak, and is a history of general value.
