STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to protect cod and other ground fish in waters off the coast of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for or take, except 2 with trawls or ordinary hooks and lines, any cod or other 3 ground fish from the waters subject to the jurisdiction of 4 this state.

Sect. 2. Any person who fishes for or takes fish contrary 2 to the provisions of this act shall be punished for each of-3 fence by a fine of not less than two hundred or more than 4 one thousand dollars, or by imprisonment not less than 2

5 three or more than twelve months, and shall further forfeit 6 five dollars for each fish so taken.

Sect. 3. Sections fifty-nine, sixty and sixty-one of chap-2 ter forty-one of the Revised Statutes shall apply to all of-3 fences under this act.
