STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of building a highway bridge across
Crooked River between the Towns of Casco and Naples,
in the County of Cumberland.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of three thousand dollars (\$3000) to aid in the con-
3 struction of a bridge across Crooked river between the towns
4 of Casco and Naples, provided that there be appropriated by
5 said towns of Casco and Naples or otherwise, the sum of
6 two thousand dollars (\$2000) for the same purpose: both
7 sums to be expended under the supervision of the State
8 Highway Department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The present bridge is a wooden structure of two spans, about 80 feet in length, with a center pier. It is considered advisable to have the center pier removed and make a one-span bridge and improve the present granite abutments by the addition of concrete or rebuilding the same. The bridge is now considered unsafe for travel.
