STATE OF MAINE

AMENDMENT A—HOUSE DOCUMENT NO. 193.

Amend House Document No. 193 by striking out all of said
2 Resolve after the word "Agriculture" in the third line of
3 printed resolve, and substitute the following:

'To study methods and cost of marketing farm products
5 and purchasing farm supplies, who shall work in conjunc-
6 tion with the Farmers Union of Maine, the Fruit Growers'
7 Associations and other farm organizations and who shall
8 have authority to employ agents and experts,' so that said
9 section shall read as follows:

Resolved, That three thousand dollars (\$3,000) be appro-
11 priated each year for 1913 and 1914, to be expended under
12 the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture to study

13 methods and cost of marketing farm products and purchas-
14 ing farm supplies, who shall work in conjunction with the
15 Farmers Union of Maine, the Fruit Growers' Associations
16 and other farm organizations and who shall have authority
17 to employ agents and experts.
