STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 504 of the Private and Special Laws
of 1889, incorporating the Otter Creek Bridge Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter five hundred and four (504) of the
2 Private and Special Laws of 1889 is hereby amended in the
3 second section thereof by striking out the words "thirty-five"
4 in the sixth line of said section and substituting therefor the
5 words 'twenty-four' and by striking out the words "thirty-
6 five" in the thirteenth line thereof and substituting the words
7 'twenty-four' so that said section as amended shall read as
8 follows:

‘Sect. 2. Said road and bridge shall be located at or near
10 said Otter creek bar, and general continuation thereof, from
11 Eden to Mount Desert, in a suitable and convenient place,
12 and said road shall be built of earth, stone, wood or other
13 good material, and of not more than four rods in width.
14 Said bridge shall contain a draw, which shall be twenty-four
15 feet in width, in the clear, and located to meet the needs of
16 navigation at that point, and said company may build, erect
17 and maintain such piers, abutments and other structures, as
18 it may deem necessary in the premises, within and without
19 said four rod limit. Said company is to so construct said
20 bridge that there shall always be one hundred feet in the
21 clear, including said twenty-four feet of draw, for the un-
22 obstructed influx and efflux of tide.’

Sect. 2. The towns of Eden and Mt. Desert or either of
2 them are hereby authorized to contribute such sums toward
3 the cost of construction of said road and bridge as they may
4 vote to contribute at any legal meeting of the inhabitants
5 thereof.

Sect. 3. The organization of said corporation and the
2 transfer of stock in the same by assignment from Caroline
3 Wellington and Louise W. Peaslee, heirs of Cornelius Well-
4 ington, one of the corporators named in said act, and the
5 holding of said stock, by the Otter Creek Reality Company,
6 a corporation existing under the law of Maine and located at
7 said Otter Creek, are hereby authorized and made valid.
