STATEMENT OF FACTS ACCOMPANYING RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF BETSEY A. DYER.

Betsey A. Dyer, who is now about eighty years of age, is the widow of an old soldier and in rather destitute circumstances. She now receives four dollars per month from the State and wishes an increase of four dollars, making the pension eight dollars per month.
