#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Rangeley, Cupsuptic and Mooselucmeguntic lakes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall at any time fish in Rangeley,

- 2 Cupsuptic or Mooselucmeguntic lakes, or either of them, in
- 3 any way or manner than by the usual method of trolling or
- 4 with unbaited artificial flies cast in the usual manner.
- Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
- 2 act shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more
- 3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense.
