STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Rangeley, Cupsuptic and Moose-  
lucmeguntic lakes.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. No person shall at any time fish in Rangeley,  
2 Cupsuptic or Mooselucmeguntic lakes, or either of them, in  
3 any way or manner than by the usual method of trolling or  
4 with unbaited artificial flies cast in the usual manner.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this  
2 act shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more  
3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense.
