IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 503 of the Private and Special Laws of 1828, as amended by chapter 508 of the Private and Special Laws of 1874 and by Chapter 254 of the Private and Special Laws of 1876, relating to the taking of fish in Naraguagus river.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
