STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT for the better protection of Shell Fish within the town of Kennebunkport in the County of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. No shell fish shall be taken from any flats with2 in the limits of the town of Kennebunkport, in York Coun3 ty, except by written permit of the municipal officers of the
4 said town of Kennebunkport, and payment to the said town
5 for the privilege at such price as said town may establish
6 at any town meeting, any existing laws to the contrary not7 withstanding; provided, that without such permit, any inhab8 itant within said town, or any person temporarily resident
9 therein, or the riparian owner of any such flats, may take

10 therefrom for the immediate use of himself or his family, 11 not exceeding one bushel at one tide.

Sect. 2. Any person taking shell fish contrary to the pro-2 visions of this act, shall be punished for each offense by a 3 fine not exceeding ten dollars, or by imprisonment not ex-4 ceeding thirty days or by both.
